Free home fire safety visits for seniors

It is vital you are prepared in the event of a house fire so you & your loved ones have the best chance of staying safe. Here are some tips to ensure you are as prepared as possible should a fire eventuate:

Make sure you have working smoke alarms fitted throughout your home, including in bedrooms so you will be alerted as soon as possible if there is a fire

Create a home escape plan to ensure you know the quickest & safest possible exit

- Keep keys in door & window locks in case of an emergency - every second counts
- In the event of a fire: get out, stay out & call 000
- Wait for the firefighters to arrive & never go back inside until advised by firefighters or police.

Book your free safety visit as soon as possible. Firefighters will come to your home to inspect your smoke alarms & replace them for free if needed. You can call your local fire station or call 9265 2999 & they can direct your call.

Home Library Service

If you're unable to visit a Blue Mountains library branch, you may be eligible to have library items delivered to your home free of charge! The service is for residents who are frail, housebound, living with illness/disability, in an aged care facility & for carers. Call 4780 5040 (Springwood) or 4780 5750 (Katoomba).
