## What is Campylobacter?

Campylobacter is an infection that most commonly causes gastroenteritis but may also cause illness affecting the whole body.

Eating contaminated food is the most common cause of this infection. It is most commonly found in raw or undercooked poultry & meat, but also in raw milk & contaminated water.



Symptoms of infection include diarrhoea, fever & cramps.

To prevent this type of infection you should wash your hands after handling raw meat, especially poultry, & keep food preparation areas clean. Wash your hands after gardening or touching animals. Make sure your meat, particularly poultry, is thoroughly cooked. Do not store uncooked poultry or other meat near foods which will be eaten raw, such as salad items.

You should seek medical advice if you believe you have food poisoning and have signs of dehydration, lethargy, a dry mouth, if you are feeling faint, have a fever, severe abdominal pain or bloody diarrhoea.
